Students Must:

1. Follow the guidelines on the MLK's Flyer
2. Attend Elementary, Middle or High School
3. Draw on 8 ^{1/2} by 11 paper
4. BASE DRAWING ON THEME AND MLK'S QUOTE

Theme: "Stand In Unity For Humanity" and "All labor that uplifts humanity has dignity and importance and should be undertaken with painstaking excellence." Martin Luther King, Jr.

5. Include first name, last name, age, school, and phone number on the back of the artwork. There will be a first, second and third grade in each level: Elementary, Middle and High School.
6. First place winners will receive a \$30 gift card from Wal-Mart, first place ribbon and medal
7. Second place winners will receive a \$20 gift card from Wal-Mart, second place ribbon and medal
8. Third place winners will receive a \$10 gift card from Wal-Mart, third place ribbon and medal
9. All other participants will receive participants ribbons
10. Students will receive copies of their drawings
