### Parade Rules

In order to ensure the safety of everyone it is necessary to follow the guidelines listed below:

- Walkers are welcome.
- You may register a valid motor vehicle (car/truck) in the parade.
- Motorcycles or Motorcycle Clubs are welcome.
- Vehicles should have a poster/sign on both sides of the vehicle doors that state the identity of the community/organization that is being represented.
- All drivers and passengers must act in accordance with North Carolina laws regulating motor vehicles.
  - Ex. Driver must have a valid license.
  - Children under the age of 12 cannot ride in the back of a pickup truck.
- No one in the parade can wear a mask unless it is noted with Concord Police Department prior to the event.
- Inappropriate behavior for such an event will not be tolerated such as use of alcohol, shouting of obscenities, throwing of objects from the parade unit, shouting of inappropriate phrases, etc.
- Only units that register will be allowed in the parade line-up. Deadline to register is January 15, 2019.
